5. New Business

a. Main Committee Membership

It is a good opportunity to increase diversity, and understand what is going on in the other committees. b. C37.13.1

It has been suggested that there is potentially some confusing text in C37.13.1 regarding ratings and testing text associated with power factor. Ted Olsen and Paul Barnhart are working with Bob Puckett to draft a proposal for the WG, which should result in a corrigendum to be balloted before the next meeting.

c. C37.18

This document has been re-affirmed more times than is allowable (last revision in 1976). The document must either be withdrawn, or requires a PAR by the end of the calendar year.

Discussion was held regarding whether there is a need to maintain this document. There were no known new applications for this type of circuit breaker, only refurbishments and replacements for existing installations. Ted Olsen moved to allow IEEE to administratively withdraw C37.18 when it expires (December 2008), with Allan Morse seconding the motion. The vote passed unanimously, with three abstentions.

d. AMS System

Attendance will be recorded through the AMS system for the WG and LVSD Subcommittee. This is the first meeting utilizing the AMS system.
