- 1. Welcome and introductions of all participants. The WG meeting was attended by 46 participants (28 members)
- 2. The WG Chair reviewed IEEE Policy on patents and Other Guidelines for IEEE WG Meetings
- 3. The minutes of the WG meeting in Orlando were approved by the members of the WG.
- 4. IEEE Std C37.10 "IEEE Guide for Diagnostics and Failure Investigation of Power Circuit Breakers" has been reaffirmed on May 09, 2008
- 5. IEEE Std 1325 "IEEE Recommended Practice for Reporting Field Failure Data for Power Circuit Breakers" has been reaffirmed on May 09, 2008
- 6. The WG decided to combine both documents in this revision and use C37.10 as the number of the new document.
- 7. Recommendations from members and guests were compiled on draft 0.2a and it was circulated among members and guests.
- 8. The title was agreed to be:
 - IEEE Guide for Investigation, Analysis and Reporting of Power Circuit Breaker Failures
- 9. The scope was agreed to be:
 - This guide provides practices and processes to perform, analyze, and report of power circuit breaker failures
- 10. The purpose was agreed to be:
 - The purpose of this guide is:
 - a) to provide guidelines and promote uniformity in the analysis of power circuit breaker failures;
 - b) to provide guidance for systematic and uniform data collection so that valuable facts are not lost or destroyed;
 - c) to provide a methodology by which the most probable cause of any particular circuit breaker failure may be determined;
 - d) to encourage cooperative efforts by users and manufacturers during failure analysis;
 - e) to provide guidance for reporting failures for power circuit breakers
- 11. The proposed outline of the document was presented to the WG and several volunteers were assigned to work on it. When more than one person was assigned to a specific part of the document, a group leader was assigned to coordinate their part of the document.

- 12. It was agreed that the Chair will request approval of Switchgear HVCB to proceed with an application for a PAR.
- 13. All the parts of the document will be collected on December 10, 2008 and a new draft will be circulated among members of the WG.
