STLNA LIASION REPORT TO THE MAIN SWITCHGEAR COMMITTEE October 1, 2009

- Kirk Smith has been reelected as STLNA chair and Frank DeCesaro as STLNA technical liaison director.
- The change in NEMA secretariat affected the new member application process. The application process is being reviewed and a defined procedure will be created.
- Paul Leufkens of KEMA represented the STLNA at the spring STL Management Committee meeting in CESI. Some highlights are:
 - The STL performed on-site peer review of two applicant labs (KERI of Korea and CHPTL of China). Assessment report is pending for:
 - o The STL guides to fuse standards IEC 60282-1 and -2 created by the STLNA were accepted and placed in service.
 - o The new STL web site is still not available. It should be soon. STL guides would then be available to the public free.
 - o Mr. Nicolini replaced Mr. Steffens as Chair of STLMC for a three year term.
 - o Mr. Faber of FGH was elected chair of the STL technical committee for the next three years replacing Mr. Figini.
- STLNA labs are preparing to participate in the STL current shunt project in 2010.
- A standard's interpretation form has been created for anyone who wants a testing interpretation by the STLNA members.
 - o STLNA members discuss the interpretation request via email rather than wait until the next meeting.
 - An email ballot will be taken if there is not a consensus of resolution.
 - If appropriate, the request will be forwarded to the STL Technical committee, which meets each fall for final resolution.
