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- This document is for current limiting reactors. The document includes information on the effects of TRV on switching devices in reactor circuits, which we feel is outside of the scope of the Transformer Committee. Jeff is conveying our objections. Also, a check of the PAR shows no discussion of the effect on switching devices in the PAR, so such discussion is outside the scope of the approved PAR for the project.
- - Joint working group meeting was held in Myrtle Beach.
 - The document is moving forward and significant progress has been made.
 - A more definitive report can be found among the RODE subcommittee minutes.
 - IEEE-SA staff provided valuable assistance in working through issues related to the dual-logo agreement.
- - Dual logo ballot in IEC failed due to insufficient number of experts.
 - Remove from future agenda.
- C37.013 (HV Generator CBs IEC 17A WG52) Constructive Comments from IEC 17AB. Long
 - Draft document in process.
 - J. Haasz working to keep the IEC IEEE dual logo process on track.
 - Still experiencing problems with procedures.
 - Concern that the C37.013 designation may disappear but final result still uncertain.
 - Discussion of the previous motion that dual logo documents should maintain two numbers, the C37 number plus the IEC number. Opinion offered that when we expressed our desires in the earlier motion that we were unaware that there was a conflict between this intention and the written agreement between IEC and IEEE.

NEW BUSINESS / ROUND TABLE

- - To control expenses and avoid going into the red (which we cannot do), we need some way to increase the funds for food. The present discussions with the Tropicana will result in a very low room rate. One proposal is to increase the room rate by a small amount (e.g., \$10) and credit this to our food expenses. Alternatively, we could impose a higher meeting registration rate for those not staying in the meeting hotel. Another alternative is simply to increase the meeting registration fee and keep the hotel room rate lower. T. Burse moved to increase the meeting registration fee by \$50 (second J. Nelson) for Las Vegas. Passed unanimously.
