Patents:

General:

The PAR for this project was approved by the IEEE-SA Standards Board on December 5, 2012, and is valid through 2016. A revision to the PAR to extend to include 1000 Vac was approved by the IEEE-SA Standards Board on August 21, 2014.

Ballot comment resolution:

A document with all ballot comments (including one roque comment submitted outside the system) was circulated on 30-August, with draft (strawman) resolutions. Those considered by the chair and vice-chair as simple to resolve were shown on the document without highlight. Those comments considered to be controversial or in need of further discussion in the working group meeting in Asheville were highlighted.

The comments were reviewed and consensus reached on the "disposition status" and "disposition details" during the meeting.

- Comment i-152: Strawman rejected. Disposition: revised, Disposition detail: add the suggested language for item d) as a new item c) as suggested in the comment.
- Comment i-94: Strawman rejected. Disposition: revised, and detail: Add to end of the first sentence in line 1705, ", and the compartment door shall be able to be closed with the circuit breaker in the disconnect position."
- Comment i-87: A task force consisting of N. McQuin, J. Shullaw, and G. Nourse will draft an annex that reflects information from the C37.20.8 task force on shunts for inclusion in the next draft for
- Comment i-86: Disposition: revised, detail: revised to use the suggested language except with the end being * . functions shall be blocked or otherwise made inoperable".
- Comment 83: Revised in light of changes to i-61. Disposition: revised, detail: Delete single phase testing in line 927 (re: 6.2.4.1.1) and in line 902 (clause 6.2.4), change the sentence to "This test shall be conducted as a three phase test, except for the tests of the ground bus and the neutral bus in 6.2.4.2 and 6.2.4.3."
- Comment i-61: Disposition: revised, detail: delete single phase testing in line 927 (re: 6.2.4.1.1) and in line 902 (clause 6.2.4), change the sentence to "This test shall be conducted as a three phase test, except for the tests of the ground bus and the neutral bus in 6.2.4.2 and 6.2.4.3."
- Comment i-42: Disposition: rejected, detail: No change suggested and no change necessary.
- Comment i-121 and i-114: Disposition: revised, detail: replace with "... a wire no larger than no.10 AWG copper.
- Comment i-129: Disposition: revised, and detail: change to "... are located within the circuit breaker element and not accessible except by removable of barriers, guards, or covers.

The chair and vice-chair will incorporate the agreed changes into the draft, including output of the task group relative to comment i-87. Following this, the revised draft and revised list of comments with dispositions will be recirculated to the working group. After consensus, a ballot recirculation will be initiated. It is hoped that all of this can be completed such that the recirculation ballot can be launched before the end of 2014.
